**Mel Hughes Scholarship (Allegacy FCU) -** Four \$1300 and four \$250 scholarships are available through Allegacy FCU. If you are a member of Allegacy with at least a 3.0 GPA visit www.allegacyfcu.org/scholarships to pick up an application in guidance. **Deadline February 11,** 

**Golden Leaf Foundation:** 215 scholarships are awarded each year to students demonstrating financial need and enroll in an NC public university or qualifying private college. Scholarships are valued at \$12,000 (\$3000 a year). Applications will become available in January, however students can visit CFNC.org/goldenleaf for more information. **Deadline for applications and FAFSA is March 1.** 

**Stokes County Arts Council Scholarship:** available to Stokes County residents graduating from one of the county high schools planning to major in and pursue a career in an arts related field. For more information pertaining to eligibility and to pick up an application see Mrs. Sawyer. **Deadline March 15.** 

**SECU People Helping People Scholarship:** one recipient per school valued at \$10,000 (\$1250 paid per semester) to attend one of the 16 colleges in the UNC system. Eligible seniors must have been accepted to one of the 16 UNC system schools, be a US citizen and resident of NC, exemplifies the philosophy of People Helping People through demonstrated leadership, excellence of character, integrity, and community involvement. For more information see Mrs. Sawyer. **Deadline March 25.** 

Janice M. Scott Memorial Scholarship: 3-5 scholarships for a one time award of \$2500 available for high school seniors who have a 3.0 GPA or higher, will be enrolling full time in an accredited college or university within the 50 states or DC, have demonstrated leadership abilities, and who demonstrate financial need by parents' income not exceeding \$100,000 a year. Applications are available in guidance. Deadline March 31.

Whitlow-Osborne Scholarship: Students planning to enter an emergency services curriculum at a community college, technical institute, or trade school are encouraged to apply for this local scholarship valued at \$2000 (\$500 paid each semester). Awards based on scholastic achievement, intellectual ability, financial need, character, and promise of future contribution to society. Applications available in the Counseling Office. Deadline March 31.

Abbott & Fenner Scholarship - \$1000 scholarship available high school seniors based on an essay regarding the following topic: What have you done outside the classroom that demonstrates qualities sought after by the post secondary institution that you are hoping to attend? ## FINANCIAL AID

Your applications are submitted and now you begin the waiting game.....

But while you wait you can get yourself squared away with the financial aid process. This can be confusing so join us Thursday, January 17 at 7:00 pm in the Media Center for an informational presentation from Melanie Matthews—a financial aid representative from Surry Community College. This will be an overview of the FAFSA, loans, grants, and an opportunity to have some questions answered about the process.

Everyone pursuing education after graduation, be it a 4-year program, a 2-year program, or a vocational program should plan on completing the FAFSA (free application for federal student aid) in February. Encourage parents to complete their taxes early - the earlier you complete this application the more money you may have the opportunity to receive for college. Visit www.fafsa.ed.gov to apply for your pin and begin the application process for 2013-2014 school year. Parents will need to apply for a pin as well. Also, please join un on Tuesday, February 7 at 6:00 pm in the Media Center for FAFSA Night at South Stokes. Financial Aid volunteers will be available to assist parents and students complete the FAFSA online.

Students unable to attend SSHS FAFSA night and still needing assistance completing the application can also take advantage of the state wide FAFSA Day on Saturday, February 23. Check www.cfnc.org for nearby locations.
