Selection is very competitive and students should have high SAT?ACT scores, grades, participated in extracurriculars, been involved in the community and/or been employed. Forsyth Tech Placement Test

Representatives from Forsyth Technical Community College will be at South Stokes on Friday, November 9 to administer the placement test that is required for applicants to complete. This placement test will help determine which courses you will be enrolled in during your first semester at FTCC. Being well prepared and scoring well may allow you to skip taking remedial English and Math courses, which can cost around \$300 for each course and not count towards your degree. Mrs. Sawyer will be meeting with students that have indicated they were applying to Forsyth Tech in order to give you prep materials.

KNOW YOUR DEADLINES!!!!

Make sure you know when your college applications are due. Most applications for 4 year colleges should be completed by December. Community College applicants should plan to have materials submitted in January. The sooner you apply the sooner you know if you're accepted! Also, often earlier deadlines give students more chances to be considered for institutional scholarships. As you get acceptance letters, be sure to bring them to Mrs. Sawyer so I can make copies and display them proudly!!

No more than 6 absences and an A average No more than 4 absences and a B average No more than 2 absences and a C average

Attendance Policies

Students that miss 14 or more days in any class are automatically subject to lose credit for that course. Students that have reached the 14 day mark will receive an attendance waiver application in December that will be subject to review by a school based committee. Decisions will include credit, no credit, or mandatory make up time to earn your credit back. If you believe you have missed 14 days or more be on the lookout for attendance waiver applications.
