

### **Cognitive Abilities Test – Thursday, September 20**

All **freshmen** will be taking the Cognitive Abilities Test next Thursday during 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> period. The Cognitive Abilities Test is an aptitude test that measures students' reasoning abilities in verbal, mathematical, and nonverbal areas. There are no preparations that students can do at home to prepare for the test.

Most students will test with their  $1^{st}$  period classes. Students will test receive their test room assignments before the day of the test.

## North Carolina Governor's School

Governor's School is a six-week summer residential program for academically talented **juniors**. Nominees in visual and performing arts (including chorus, band, and dance) are also eligible for consideration. All applicants must meet stiff academic requirements. # **PSAT REGISTRATION**

A CHEAP, EASY PAY TO PREPARE FOR COLLEGE ADMISSIONS TESTS!

Sophomores and <u>juniors</u> planning to apply to four-year colleges and universities are strongly encouraged to sign up for the PSAT that will be administered here at South Stokes in October. In addition to being a great, inexpensive way to practice for the SAT, it is the qualifying test for the National Merit Scholarship Program for juniors. Juniors, if you took the test last year, you should sign up again to help boost your scores on the SAT and possibly qualify for scholarship monies.

The PSAT costs \$14 and students interested in taking the test should sign up in the Counseling Office by September 28. Fee waivers are available to juniors who meet eligibility requirements as well. Freshmen may also take the test if they are interested in getting a head start on preparing for college admissions tests. If you have any questions, please see the counselors.
